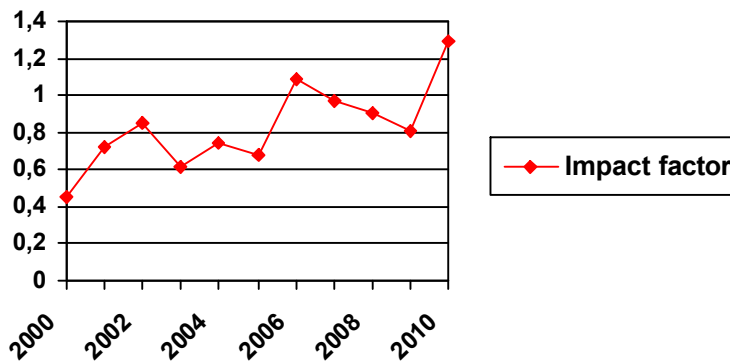
Editor in Chief is Jan Adolfsson, Stockholm, and editor for renal medicine is Stefan Jacobson, Stockholm. The Society Acta Chirurgica owns the Journal and it is published by INFORMA

In total 72 papers were published 2010 whereof 11 case reports.

Mean time from accept to publication was 4.8 months and the papers are published electronically as soon as the proof has been cleared.

The Journal has almost 1300 primary subscribers where the majority is members in the Nordic associations. The journal is available through approximately 500 libraries and reaches around 5000 other subscribers through “third party providers”. The Journal is also available to about 2000 institutions in the third world though the HINARI project by WHO.

The refusal rate was 86% for 2010 and the impact factor is 1.293



This is my last year as Editor-in-Chief and Per-Uno Malmström will take over from January 1, 2012. He will act as associate editor during the autumn 2011.

I would like to thank all in the editorial board and all referees who have helped me trough the years.
