

## Summery from the NoRenCa Meeting held at Arlanda, Stockholm the 10<sup>th</sup> of December 2018

1. Chair Christian Beisland welcomes the whole group.  
Professor Christian Beisland has decided to step back due to heavy workload. Lars Lund was elected as next chair for NoRenCa for a period of maximum four years. The group expressed great gratitude the all the work that Christian has done for Norencan the last years.
2. We then discussed the preliminary program at the coming NUF meeting in Island presented by Eirikur. We discussed the different topics and pointed out the speakers. We had a renal cancer presentation at Thursday and Friday. Please look at the website of NUF 2019. IS.
3. Harry presented his suggestion for NoRenCa study three. There was a lively debate concerning this. Harry has done a tremendous work preparing this draft. We decided to split it up in two investigations, one concerning Bosniak IIF and a study concerning Bosniak type III. Lars, Nessn and Christian will take care of suggestions for the study concerning the Bosniak type IIF and Harry will continue with Bosniak type III. These topics will be discussed at the Skype meeting held in week four/five in January 2019.
4. Nessn presented NoRenCa study four. Nessn will go back and calculate the numbers needed to be enrolled in the present study because the actual number that was presented was not accurate enough. This will also be discussed at the Skype meeting.
5. A picture was taken of the whole group but unfortunately Frode was not shown in a whole person. However we have decided to put the present picture on the website with the new names and when we meet in Island we can take a new picture.
6. Lars has contacted the webmaster of NUF and has presented the new ideas with Ph.D. students from each of the Scandinavian countries and also updated the members.
7. We have decided to have a symposium/course in renal cancer for two days. Bjarne Kromann will be present at this meeting at Herlev. We have reserved a small auditorium which does not cost anything. Price for food per day is 120 DKK per participant. We have asked if there will be any cost to transmit the live operations so we can have the total amount concerning this. We will try to seek funding from different pharmaceutical companies in order to have this symposium. We need to handle it before our Skype meeting in order to prepare the symposium so we can get it announced in our societies and on our website as soon as possible in order to see that there will be enough attendees to this. If possible we will make a follow up of the VTE study in order to see whether people have changed their treatment for antithrombotic treatment in patients with renal cancer before and after surgery. Lars will prepare some questions and mail them around together with the email list. This will be circulated next week.

A doodle will come very soon regarding a date for the Skype meeting so please do this as soon as possible so we can arrange the Skype meeting. **I do hope that Petrus will take care of inviting us all for a Skype meeting when we have the exact date ready.**
