

Department for reconstructive urology and neuro urology, Rikshospitalet, Oslo



Do you want to visit the Department for reconstructive urology and neuro urology, Rikshospitalet, Oslo, and take part in the activity for a week?

It is a small urological department with four senior, and two junior doctors, and junior doctors from Scandinavia are invited to visit for a week and take part in the activity.

The main focus is reconstructive surgery in the lower urinary tract, for example incontinence surgery with slings or sphincter prosthesis, urethra- and penile surgery in addition to benign urinary deviations and bladder reconstructions.

The operation program will differ from week to week. Small adjustments in the program can be made if there are certain areas that are of special interest for the visitor.

You are also welcome to observe in the outpatient clinic where you will see a broad spectrum of benign urological conditions and cases.

Travel;

Oslo Airport Gardermoen is located 52km from Rikshospitalet. You can travel from the airport to the city centre by train or bus. From the city centre you can take tram number 17 or 18 directly to the hospital.
