2. Scandinavian Course on Ureteroscopy “Ureteroskopi – praxis i Skandinavien II” (chaired by Roberts Swartz) was held in Örebro Sweden October 26 – 28, 2011.

Annual practical training course in urological endoscopy. Modellkurs 2012:

The course took place in Örebro April 13-14, organized by Robert Swartz. Per Esben Laahne, Marianne Brehmer and Kim H. Andreassen participated as instructors. As scheduled 12 residents participated (6 from Sweden, 3 from Norway and 3 from Denmark). The course had very good evaluations from the participants.

The need/demand for this course has decreased, since equal national courses are available. It has been decided to discontinue this course.

4th Scandinavian Course on Urinary Stone Disease, 2012.

The course took place in Legoland, Billund, chaired by Kim Hovgaard Andreassen. A total of 101 participated (65 course participants, 23 from companies/exhibition and 13 from faculty. Of the 65 regular course participants 29 were residents, 18 urologists, 15 nurses and 3 others.

Denmark: 29, Sweden: 26, Norway: 6 and Finland: 4.

The course had very good evaluations from the participants.
