

## **Webmaster report for NUF General Assembly 2025 in Göteborg**

Since the last General Assembly, the primary focus of the webmaster role has been an update and modernization of the NUF website, nuf.nu. This was driven by both aesthetic and functional needs. The previous version of the website had become outdated in terms of both its graphic design and infrastructure. Additionally, the outdated webpage had security vulnerabilities, as some users may have noticed issues with outdated security certificates when accessing the site.

During the process the board emphasized the need for a website that would be visually refreshed, easier to maintain, and more modern security and usability. In addition, it was considered important to make information about events, meetings, and congresses more accessible and easier to share on social media platforms.

After looking into a few different options, we decided to work with Brand by Hand, a web development company based in Aarhus. They offer modern and user-friendly WordPress solutions and seemed like a good fit for our needs, especially in terms of creating a secure and easy-to-maintain website.

The website redevelopment process was carried out primarily in close collaboration with me, and during the initial phase, with Nessn Azawi. The final draft of the website has been reviewed and formally approved by the NUF board.

I am pleased to report that the new version of nuf.nu went live on June 3rd, 2025, just in time for the start of the congress in Göteborg.
